NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 81 of the North-Eastern Areas (Re-organisation) Act, 1971 (81 of 1971), the Governor is pleased to order that the functions exercisable by the Administrator of Tripura (whether called the Chief Commissioner or the Lieutenant Governor or the Administrator) under any of the laws mentioned in the Schedule below shall, as from the appointed day, until other provision is made in this regard, be exercised by the State Government.
